### **New Website Goes Live!!!**

#### **Jordan Dam Latest**

Work continues on finalising the planning application. This includes a desk study to review any potential contaminated land issues associated with the site. Discussions continue with the Environment Agency regarding the abstraction application; these have been delayed slightly pending an update to the environmental assessment.

### **Kelham Island Latest**

The planning application has been submitted and can be viewed on the council's website - application no. 10/03826/full. We are now in a period of consultation after which the council will come to its decision. As with Jordan Dam we are talking to the Environment Agency about abstraction issues and the environmental assessment. We have also had further planning sessions to continue work clearing out the goit with the aim of preparing the way for another flow test later in the year. ## **European Funding**

Good progress on our capital fund raising. We are through to the next phase of a large European funding bid, which we hope will provide the grant component of both Kelham Island and Jordan Dam projects. There is a lot of work needed now to draft and finalise the more detailed documents required to support the bid.

## **Share Offer 2011**

In parallel with the grant application, we are gearing up to run and promote our share offer through 2011. Our intention is to run this in two phases. Firstly, an initial offer during the spring which, rather like our offer last year, will be targeted at people who have already expressed an interest in

investing. This will pave the way to a full public offer in the second half of the year. We have a raft of activities and initiatives planned to help attract investors and we will be using our new easy to use website and blog to keep everybody informed.
