# Jordan Dam

We are working steadily towards discharging planning conditions. One piece of work ongoing is ground gas monitoring at Jordan Dam, part of the contaminated land surveys.

We are close to a final draft of the fish pass specification that we hope will ease the approval of the abstraction licence. Meanwhile, good progress is being made by the Procurement Team working on specifying the tendering process and documentation for the civils, electrical and fish pass works.

We have attended two events in Tinsley as part of our community engagement.

# Kelham Island

Following the successful work day in August, we are continuing the work to better understand the flows in the goit. Meanwhile we're continuing discussions with the Council with a view to gaining planning conditions.

### Share Offer

The Early Bird Share Offer was launched on September 3<sup>rd</sup> and exceeded our expectations. We received £67,000. This investment has put us well on the way to achieve the total we need, and is a very encouraging start before we launch the full public share offer.

### **PowerStation Sheffield**

We had a successful volunteer evening playing Matt's online renewable energy trump game. This helped Matt iron out some of the 'bugs'. The software is going through Beta testing and will be launched as soon as that's finished.

Going forward we are hoping to put together a small team of volunteers that can do sessions with community organisations and schools, ensuring the free resources are used and kept up to date. ### Management Support
