Jordan Dam Hydro will:

- generate 80 average homes' worth of electricity
- save 170 tonnes of carbon dioxide each year
- use any profits to develop other Sheffield energy schemes

The refurbishment of the small mill building in Millhouses Park includes:

- install solar electric panels
- add a ground source heat pump
- save 0.5 tonnes of carbon dioxide each year
